

**ARMONA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT  
RESOLUTION NO. 1997-2**

**RESOLUTION GOVERNING METER TESTING AND  
ADJUSTMENT OF BILL FOR METER ERROR**

WHEREAS, the Armona Community Services District (the "District") is a community services district established pursuant to the provisions of the Community Services District Law; and

WHEREAS, the Armona Community Services District is the operator of a domestic water supply system in the Armona area of the County of Kings, State of California, and presently provides domestic water service to approximately 1,000 connections; and

WHEREAS, meters are installed or will be installed at each connection; and

WHEREAS, a customer of Armona Community Services District may believe that the meter is not registering properly; and

WHEREAS, the customer may ask for a test by the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Armona Community Services District hereby sets forth the following procedures relative to the testing and re-testing of meters.

1. A customer may request Armona Community Services District to test the meter serving the customer's premises.
2. Upon receiving the request, the District will perform a test of the meter on site.
3. If, the customer is not satisfied with the results of the District's test, the customer may deposit \$100.00 with the District for the cost of shipping and testing the meter by an outside firm.
4. A written report showing the results of the re-test will be delivered to the customer within fifteen (15) days after completion of the test.
5. If a meter is found to be registering more than two (2) percent fast, the customer will receive a refund of the overcharge for the period the meter was in use, but not exceeding six (6) months.
6. When a meter for a domestic or residential service is more than twenty-five (25) percent slow, the customer may be billed for the undercharge for the

period the meter was in service, but not exceeding six (6) months. When a meter used other than for a domestic or residential service is more than five (5) percent slow, the customer may be billed for the undercharge for the period the meter was in service, but not to exceed six (6) months.

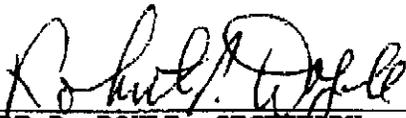
- 7. If a meter does not register, the District may bill the customer at the normal monthly metered rate or upon an estimate of the consumption, based on the customer's prior use during the same season of the year, if consumption remained unchanged.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution was passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Directors of Armona Community Services District on this 2nd day of July, 1997, by the following vote:
