

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-3
RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE ARMONA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
CALLING GENERAL DISTRICT ELECTION

The Board of Directors of the Armona Community Services District does hereby find:

WHEREAS, the Armona Community Services District ("District") is a California community services district formed and existing under and by virtue of the provisions of the California Community Services District Law, codified at Government Code §§ 61000-61800, inclusive, and all acts and laws amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto, and possessing all the powers thereof; and

WHEREAS, an election will be held within the Armona Community Services District on November 7, 2006, for the purpose of electing two (2) Board Members for the following positions; and:

Office	Division, if any	Name of Incumbent	Elected/Appointed Month/Year	To Be Elected for a Short Term (2 yrs) or for a Full Term (4 yrs)?
Director	At Large	James Maciel	Elected 11/4/97	4 Years
Director	At Large	Alan Danielson	Elected 11/4/97	4 Years

WHEREAS, whenever two or more elections are called to be held on the same day, in the same territory, in part of the same territory, or with a statewide election, in resident voting districts only, such elections should be consolidated; and

WHEREAS, on August 11, 2004, the District adopted Resolution No. 2004-4, "Revising Dates of Holding Elections of District Directors to Correspond to Statewide General Election Dates in Even-Numbered Years;" and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2004-4, the next general District election is scheduled to be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2006, at which time, persons to occupy the seats held by Directors Maciel and Danielson will be elected from among the candidates running, if any, and duly qualified therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Armona Community Services District requests and consents to the consolidation of this election with other elections which may be held in whole or in part of the territory of the District, as provided in Elections Code Sections 10400, 10402 and 10403; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event of a tie vote, the winner of this election shall be determined by lot as provided in Elections Code Section 15651; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Candidate pay for the publication of the Candidate's

1 Statement, pursuant to Elections Code Section 13307. The limitation on the number of words that a
2 candidate may use in his/her Candidate's Statement of Qualifications is 200 words; and

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Armona Community Services District agrees to
4 reimburse the County of Kings for the actual costs incurred by the County Elections Official of the
5 County of Kings in conducting the general district election for this District pursuant to Elections Code
6 Section 10520.

7 WHEREFORE, this Resolution is passed and adopted by the Board of Directors of the Armona
8 Community Services District on April 12, 2006, by the following vote:
