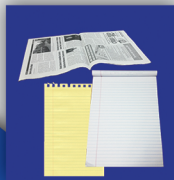
# AB 341

## Mandatory Commercial Recycling Law

AB341 requires commercial and public entities that generate 4 cubic yards or more of solid waste per week and multi-family apartments with 5 or more units to subscribe to recycling services by July 1, 2012.

### Accepted Items

- Paper Products  
*Newspaper/Cardboard/Magazines*
- Plastic Products  
*Empty Bottles/ Cartons/ Containers*
- Aluminum & Metal Products  
*Aluminum Cans/Tin Cans*
- Glass Products  
*Bottles/Jars*



# AB 1826

## Mandatory Commercial Organics Recycling Law

California law AB 1826 went into effect in 2016. AB 1826 requires businesses and schools that generate 4 or more cubic yards of organic waste to implement a recycling program—with full implementation realized in 2017.

### Accepted Items

- Natural Plant & Garden Clippings
- Grass
- Soiled Paper Plates & Cups



\*Organic waste includes yard trimmings, non-hazardous wood and soiled paper
