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FOLLOWING IS THE MINUTES FOR THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING OF THE LATON COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT. THE MEETING WAS HELD JULY 17, 2024, AT 6:00 P.M. IN THE EVENING AT THE LATON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CAFETERIA LOCATED AT 6065 EAST LATONIA STREET, LATON, CALIFORNIA. ALL DISTRICT MEETINGS ARE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA LAW.

- 1. **CALL TO ORDER**: Mrs. Hall called the Meeting to order at 6:05 pm. Board Members in attendance were Carol Hall, Francisco Orbe, and Lucy Nino. The following individuals were also present at the meeting: Dan Chapa and Ty Mizote, the following individuals were absent from the meeting: Tim Wolfe, Chief Pentecost, Paul Garcia, Jim Wegley, and JoAnne Rempp.
- 2. **UNSCHEDULED ORAL PRESENTATIONS**: Mr. Chapa informed the board that the deadline to register our wells with GSA well registration program will be September 30, 2024. Laton High School is forming a Adhoc Committee to help find grants to upgrade their cafeteria and Mr. Orbe will be on that committee.
- 3. **APPROVAL OF THE JUNE 19, 2024 MEETING MINUTES**: Mrs. Hall made a motion to approve the Meeting Minutes. Mr. Orbe seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
- 4. **APPROVAL OF THE JULY 2024 MONTHLY BILLS**: Mrs. Hall made a motion to approve the Monthly Bills and the bills that have not come prior to the board meeting. Mr. Orbe seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
- 5. THE LATON VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT
 - A. **DISCUSSION AND ACTION REGARDING THE MONTHLY REPORT**: No monthly report to report. Will give the report at the next board meeting. Mr. Chapa informed the Board that the Beneficiary paperwork was completed and returned.
- DISCUSSION AND ACTION REGARDING THE 2024-2025 FISCAL YEAR PRELIMINARY BUDGET RESOLUTION No. 2024-02: Mrs. Hall made a motion to approve the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year Preliminary Budget Resolution no. 2024-02. Mr. Orbe seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
- 7. DISCUSSION AND ACTION REGARDING THE LCSD AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) PROPOSED LCSD WATER METER PROJECT: Tabled to next month's meeting.
- 8. THE WATER DISTRIBUTION AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT.
 - A. **DISCUSSION AND ACTION REGARDING THE MONTHLY REPORT**: Mr. Chapa reported the well depths and drawdowns for June 2024: well #4 Static water level is at 102.28, and drawdown is 6.58; well #5 Static water level is at 107.03 and drawdown is at 8.27; well #6 Static water level is at 103.86 and drawdown is at 8.80. No BOD and TSS was reported for June. Freeboard pond level: #1-2.3ft, #2-2.8ft, #3-2.4ft, #4-5.2ft, #5-3.1ft, and #6-3.0ft.
- 9. **DISCUSSION AND ACTION REGARDING THE CDBG #2242 PROJECT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF LCSD WASTEWATER POND 7**: Mr. Chapa reported that Fresno County will be discussing this CDBG Grant at their board Meeting in September.
- 10. **DISCUSSION AND ACTION REGARDING PROPOSED LCSD PROJECTS FOR THE 2025-2026 FRESNO COUNTY'S COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**: Mr. Orbe made a motion to approve the wastewater effluent/influent meters as the proposed project. Mrs. Nino seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
- 11. MONTHLY REPORT FROM JIM WEGLEY: Mr. Wegley was absent and there was nothing to report.
- 12. MONTHLY SAFETY REPORT: Mr. Chapa had no accidents or injuries to report.

- 13. **MONTHLY REPORT FROM GENERAL MANAGER**: Mr. Chapa reported that he will be finalizing the annual financial budget, and the annual audit will be done by the end of the month.
