FOLLOWING IS THE MINUTES FOR THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING OF THE LATON COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT. THE MEETING WAS HELD SEPTEMBER 20, 2023, AT 6:00 P.M. IN THE EVENING AT THE LATON COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT BOARD OFFICE LOCATED AT 6501 EAST LATONIA, LATON, CALIFORNIA. ALL DISTRICT MEETINGS ARE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC IN ACCORDANCE WITH CALIFORNIA LAW.

- 1. **CALL TO ORDER**: Mr. Garcia called the Meeting to order at 6:03pm. Board Members in attendance were Paul Garcia, Carol Hall, Francisco Orbe, Tim Wolfe, and Lucy Nino. The following individuals were also present at the meeting; JoAnne Rempp, Dan Chapa, Chief Pentecost, and Ty Mizote. The following individuals were absent from the meeting: None.
- 2. UNSCHEDULED ORAL PRESENTATIONS: Mid Valley annual cleanup will be October 7. Community Day clan up at the youth baseball field will be September 30 from 8am-3pm.
- 3. **APPROVAL OF THE AUGUST 16, 2023 MEETING MINUTES:** Mr. Orbe made a motion to approve the Meeting Minutes. Mr. Wolfe seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
- 4. **APPROVAL OF THE SEPTEMBER 2023 MONTHLY BILLS**: Mr. Orbe made a motion to approve the Monthly Bills. Mr. Garcia seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

## 5. THE LATON VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT.

- A. **DISCUSSION AND ACTION REGARDING THE MONTHLY REPORT:** Chief Pentecost reported for the month of August there were 3-medical calls, 3-traffic accident calls, 0- vehicle fire call, 0-vegetation fire calls, 0-structural fire calls, 1-commercial/residential alarm, 0-Hazmat, 1-Electrical Hazard, 0-Fire Investigation, 0-Water Rescue, 0-Citizen Assist, and 0-Other. The Chief reported that one of their volunteers was in a car accident and they will be having a fundraiser to help pay his medical bills. The Fire Dept. is needing to replace their spreader cutters, rams, and batteries. Quotes for the equipment range from \$26,000 to \$42,000. Kings County has offered to let us borrow a set until we are able to find funding to purchase the equipment.
- DISCUSSION AND ACTION REGARDING THE LCSD AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) PROPOSED LCSD WATER METER PROJECT: Mr. Chapa reported that the Agreement has been signed and we are currently doing all the prep work and digging out all the meters.
- 7. DISCUSSION AND ACTION REGARDING A POSSIBLE GRANT TO BRING AFFORDABLE HOUSING TO THE COMMUNITY OF LATON: Fresno County is wanting to apply for a grant to allow Housing Authority to build a 60-unit apartment complex here in Laton. Mr. Chapa, Paul Garcia, and Carol Hall attended the community meeting and also had a Zoom meeting with the Housing Authority to discuss the concerns regarding the project. After much discussion Mr. Garcia made a motion to approve the letter of support. Mrs. Hall seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

## 8. THE WATER DISTRIBUTION AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT.

- A. DISCUSSION AND ACTION REGARDING THE MONTHLY REPORT: Mr. Chapa reported the well depths and drawdowns for August 2023: well #4 Static water level is at 103.47 and drawdown is 6.54; well #5 Static water level is at 104.93 and drawdown is at 7.88; well #6 Static water level is at 106.09 and drawdown is at 7.68. BOD and TSS reported: May-86.67/59.69; June-89.52/81.46; July-98.19/93.00; August-97.94/85.53.
- 9. **MONTHLY REPORT FROM JIM WEGLEY:** Mr. Wegley was not present. Mr. Chapa presented the new timeline of completion for the CDBG Project-Pond #7.
- 10. MONTHLY SAFETY REPORT: Mr. Chapa reported there were no injuries or accidents.
- 11. **MONTHLY REPORT FROM GENERAL MANAGER**: Mr. Chapa reported that the annual backflow device testing and the Barfleet smog testing has been completed. The 2022 and 2023 financial audits should be completed in about a week. The last quadrant of meters to be cleaned out for the water meter grant should be completed in the next week. Mr. Chapa and Mr. Garcia have signed a letter of support for the Fowler Ave road project. Mrs. Rempp reported that the Low Income Household Water Assistance Program has been extended through March 31, 2024.
